


Craig Padilla is an electronic music artist who has been around the music world for 25 years or longer. He has recorded many electronic music albums with various labels around the world and self-released music on Bandcamp. He caught our attention years ago with both his ambient and sequencer/berlin-school releases. His releases over the years with guitarist Marvin Allen veered into Pink Floyd territory and some of the guitar based recordings of Edgar Froese.

Nothing goes over dreamy atmospheres and pulsating sequences like some great guitar work and maybe some drums! His "Solina" recording a year ago rocked Chuck's world with its overall sound, depth and integrity and so Mike went after him for a release and the OS "The Pulse of Life" was born. Consisting of 5 tracks of hand and ear played modular sequencer music performed on the Mattson Modular synthesizer, this is the sound of the past mixed with the shadows of the new, all wrapped in analog goodness.

Electronic music is not for the narrow-minded. Xan Alexanders' musical output over the past twenty years has been one that has seen him evolve into a style completely all his own. From his beginnings in The Omega Syndicate to working as a part of Magnetron and releasing his own solo material, Xan has introduced an English angle and many different sounds and spaces to the tried and true, predominately German-based berlin-style of electronica.

Ouroboros II, Xan's thirteenth solo release, delivers six courses of syncopated rhythms and soundscapes that come deep from the wells of sound electronic music can make these days. There are many details here and oh what sounds that create a bed for the rhythms and melodies that rise and dance. Recorded between May of 2023 and June of 2024, Ouroboros II is both a journey and an experience, something way more than the sum of its' parts. The meal awaits you...bring wine.



The new album 'The Ray Bradbury Chronicles' draws inspiration from ten classic works by the great master of words, Ray Bradbury—whose phenomenal human insight, poetry, and wisdom take the form of realist stories, transcending mere fantasy and science fiction. He was a master of writing who often employed sci-fi and fantasy settings to convey something profoundly human about ordinary people like us. Utilizing "old-fashioned" composition and the toolkit of musical storytelling, here are ten tracks inspired by my favourite works.

Born in Transylvania, and as a member of the Hungarian ethnic minority, his main form of escapism during the communist dictatorship was listening to electronic music.

He built his first analogue synth as a teenager under the Ceausescu regime. Music creation began later in his home studio, which was established after relocating to the UK in the 1990s.

His CDs released by the former PeopleSound and Vitaminic indie labels were noted for their compositional versatility, creating well-received blends of medieval, ethnic, and space/ambient elements. Later on, after Amazon CD manufacturing services closed, everything transitioned to purely digital via RouteNote, released on all major streaming platforms.

One composition from his debut album was also featured on the compilation CD entitled "Noua Romanie — Rebirth of a Nation", a unique project released by Earthtone / Sonic Images Records, founded by the legendary Christopher Franke (ex-Tangerine Dream).

#### THE RAY BRADBURY CHRONICLES



Since the first cave paintings and fireside stories, art has been a vehicle of escape from the world's stressors. Philip Wilkerson and Chris Russell's Imaginary Realities was written with that escape in mind. Wrought in bright drones and glimmering flourishes, this album is a portal to another place, a reprieve from the mundane in the realm of the extraordinary.

While prior collaborations, Vague Traces and Dark Measures, took inspiration from our world, Imaginary Realities is quintessentially dreamlike, from the opening chimes of "Liftoff" to the closing chords of the title track. "Dissipation" shimmers and warbles like polarized magnets drawing closer and then receding. "Revealing the Concealed" begins with a sparse piano before blooming into a shifting nebula of harmonic textures. "Abandoning Desire" hums with contemplation, with shades of Russell's dark ambient solo work in its vibrating drones. Gentle strums add a percussive heartbeat to the drone's sonorous breaths, ritualistic in their rhythm. Then, the piece brightens, carried by a sun-washed texture from the caverns to the skies. Back and forth, it compresses and releases a seamless dance between darkness and warmth: the sound of all the needs for earthly possession, one by one, held to the light and let go. The closing title track is a sonic image of aurorae, colours swimming in the night sky.

Russell describes the joy of collaboration as "being taken to places you couldn't get by yourself," and that sense of exploration is abundant here. In its shimmering fractals of sound, Imaginary Realities gives glimpses of other worlds, inviting the listener to move from vision to vision as a voyager in a dream.

Since the mid-80s, acclaimed ambient artist Jeff Greinke has released compelling albums of evocative and seductive atmospheric music. On Late Rain, his 25th release, four featured musicians bring an abundance of acoustic instruments to Greinke's electronic soundscapes for extraordinarily textural, hauntingly ethereal, and wonderfully organic music that is both ambient and alive

Following 2024's OCEANIC, where Greinke performed all the music himself, he envisioned a follow-up release based around an ensemble. Inspired to create a vibrantly energetic group sound, he enlisted four exceptionally skilled, intuitive musicians out of the Seattle new music scene to participate in his sonic adventure.

Greinke sent each song sketches to work out their parts. He later gathered everyone in a Seattle studio to record a live session of the album. This was the ensemble's first meeting; in not knowing what the others had been working on, an excited anticipatory charge was felt in the room. Greinke created an enticing environment for the players to interact within, working around his open-ended compositions. A spirited, imaginative musical alchemy was captured during that session, culminating in an album, unlike anything in Greinke's catalogue.



# Oksana Linde



The Venezuelan composer Oksana Linde presents Travesías, her second album released by Buh Records, featuring pieces created between 1986 and 1994 in her private studio in San Antonio de Los Altos, Venezuela. These works belong to the same creative period as those in her acclaimed debut album, Aquatic and Other Worlds (Buh, 2022).

Born in 1948 in Caracas to Ukrainian immigrant parents, Oksana Linde's journey exemplifies resilience and innovation. After abandoning her career as a chemist due to health problems, Linde devoted herself to music, experimenting with synthesizers to create a profoundly evocative sonic universe. She produced many recordings during the 1980s, many of which remained unreleased until the publication of Aquatic and Other Worlds.

This new collection of pieces, taken from the extensive archive of cassette tapes preserved by Linde, unveils yet another perspective of her work. The pieces "Mundos Flotantes" (Floating Worlds), "Horizontes Lejanos" (Distant Horizons), and "Arrecifes en el espacio" (Reefs in Space) were explicitly composed for the show Travesía Acuastral (Aqua-Astral Journey), presented by Linde in February 1991 at Casa Rómulo Gallegos as part of the 3rd Encounter of New Electronic Music. This event, produced by Maite Galán in collaboration with the Musikautomatika group, was a milestone in shaping an experimental electronic music scene in Venezuela, one of the most active in Latin America then.

Travesías solidifies Oksana Linde's position as an essential figure in electronic music and furthers the effort to bring to light one of the most fascinating archives of electronic music produced in Latin America

Deuter's upcoming album Mångata, continues his tradition of blending ambient, world, and new age music. Mångata, refers to the Swedish word for the "moon path," which describes the reflection of the moon's light on water. Motivated by the desire to express deep connection with the natural world and receiving inspiration from it. Deuter is known for creating music that encourages inner peace, healing, and slowing down the madness of this world. The album invites the listener to feel both grounded and uplifted, much like the connection between the Earth and the moon's reflected light.

Lovingly referred to as simply Deuter around the world, his music has soothed, uplifted, and educated his many fans for decades. Deuter has recorded and released over 60 albums. He is fluent on an ever- expanding array of instruments including the flute, guitar, recorder, koto, shakumachi, sitar, Tibetan singing bowls, santoor, bouzouki, piano and keyboard.



#### **Joe Weineck**

For film producer, inventor and composer Joe Weineck, boundaries and stylistic definitions have always been challenging to dissolve those barriers, harmoniously combine styles, create something new, surprise, and make images and emotions audible and visible. Joe likes to use the study of composition to ignore the boundaries of his discipline confidently. Hues become timbres, images, memories and feelings that we remember fondly, even if we never experienced them before. in addition to his music,

Joe has participated in about 150 film productions since 1975 and has produced feature films in France, England and the USA for 10 years. After that, back in Germany followed an excursion into IT, so-called self-learning computer systems to "semantic computing", then the first app in 2001 and many more inventions (that you would never guess). This was followed by the commitment to the Inuit, whose fear of being robbed of their raw materials was justified. Until today, the interests of the indigenous people could be protected, which required superhuman effort. Despite all this, music, composing, jamming and producing remained the source of strength and nourishment for the soul.

Fritz Lang's 1926 masterpiece anticipates a development 100 years in the future. A wealthy elite controls everything, and the "others" are sent to work in the underworld. Anyone who recognises reality will see the parallels to today. Back then, it was a robot woman who was given the part of a woman to prevent a revolt. Today it is the so-called AI, which tends to unsettle many. Since Joe Weineck has been involved with "AI" for 25 years and has realised developments in this area, he can justifiably say that there is a lot of "A" and little "I" in it. These are rule-based systems with large databases.

There are linear links here, but that has nothing to do with intelligence. The fantastic film material that keeps the Friedrich Wilhelm Murnau Foundation alive has inspired Weineck to create completely different music to put the images in a new context. Walter Schulze-Mittendorf, the ingenious creator of the robot woman "Eva", made the model, after which almost all robots were designed in the future. The voice-based music, with various choirs and soloists, Gregorian elements, is different and timeless and lends other emotions in symbiosis with the film.





Silvia Blaser

Lucid Dreams is a profound journey into conscious dreaming, guided by the ethereal sounds of Swiss flautist Silvia Bläser and the deep ambient textures of Danish composer Lauge. Each track resonates with specific chakra frequencies, from the root chakra's grounding energy to the crown and third eye chakra's transcendent flow.


This harmonious blend of ambient pads and flute medicine offers a spiritual experience that invites the listener to connect with the earth and their higher self.

Asura is Charles Farewell, born in 1975. Initially, it was a duo consisting of Charles Farewell and Vincent Villuis. Since 1996, the project Asura has crafted a unique electronic soundscape blending trance, psychedelic, ambient, and world music. In 1998, Christopher Maze joined the band, and in 2000, the first Asura album, Code Eternity, was released. Influenced by a variety of sources, their music, constructed around electronic machines and acoustic instruments, remains a personal and thoughtful creation, centred on the endless exploration of infinite spaces and diverse origins. With hauntingly melancholic lyrics, symphonic waves, varied rhythms, and heavy or pulsating liturgical melodies, the project Asura presents a distinctive and solemn view of the world.

They had established a remarkably unique sound, making Asura one of the most recognisable bands in the World Electro and Trance Ambient genre. In 2001, Vincent Villuis left the band to focus on his new project Aes Dana and was replaced later that year by Alex Ackerman. The second album, Lost Eden, was released in 2003. Since July 2005, following the departures of Christopher Maze and Alex Ackerman, Asura has evolved into a solo project solely driven by Charles Farewell. In July 2007, the third Asura album, [ Life ], was released, followed by [ 360 ] in October 2010 and [ Radio Universe ] in late 2014.

9 years after that last full length album, Charles Farewell came back with his very distinguished sound, offering his own private versatile vision of the world, surfing between styles, continuing the tribute to the musical pioneers that influenced him.

Ivy Barkakati's second album in a decade, Desplazamiento, sits at the cosmic intersection of minimalist composition, analogue synthesizer music, drone, and rhythmic noise. Recorded at home over two sleepless weeks in June 2021 with a Dave Smith Mono Evolver Keyboard, a borrowed MFB-522 drum computer, and Ableton Live, Desplazamiento's six instrumental pieces represent an unmediated expression of the raw, internal feelings that lurked beneath the surface of Ivy's subconscious mind during the early years of the global pandemic.





From the opening notes, the music operates in dualities, balancing darkness with light as Desplazamiento unfolds with the logic of a dream, the whisper of a half-recalled memory, and the promise of music as magic and a portal into other worlds or realms of possibility. Fittingly, throughout the album, Ivy's tracks traverse a range of moods and atmospheres, spanning the oceanic trench ambience of 'Tímida', the childlike, bell-toned melodies of the title track, and the squelchy synth pads and dubby machine beats that drive 'La Misma Onda.' If there's a common thread, she desires to explore and allow the music to take her where it needs to go.






